

Materials list for Mother Earth

In our first class we will be making a standing Mother Earth for your nature gardens or puppet shows.

I will teach how to make a simple molded head that is characteristic to dollmaking, and I will also offer a simpler way of making a doll head as well.

In the material list below, I have listed both loose wool and wool roving. You can easily find wool roving and wool batting on Etsy. If you want to invest in a bulk of wool for future projects, I would suggest you order from West Earl Woolen Mill in Ephrata, Pennsylvania. They sell very reasonably priced beautifully cleaned and carded wool (bats are about 2.5 pounds). This saves a lot of money ordering this way, and you always have

some wool at your "fingertips" when creativity calls you!

I have also listed Surgitube or stockinette. Some drug stores carry the Surgitube (1" or 2") or you can also find this on Etsy as well.

Magic Cabin dolls also offers some lovely knit for doll skin, and they also sell other doll making supplies.

Materials List

8x8" Piece of wool felt for body

Circular piece of felt the same color for bottom of dress (app. 3"in circumference)

2.5'x8.5" for blouse (this fabric can be felt, or thick cotton) Wool for stuffing

Roving or wool batting for head

Cotton interlock for doll skin and hands (1/2 yard will give you what you need)

Scissors, thread, embroidery thread

4 long pipe cleaners

Felting needle and felting pad (optional)

Optional fabric for scarf and apron

7" piece of surgitube

Roving for Hair
